- ⇒ NEW THIS YEAR: Did you attend SRHS during the 2019-2020 school year? Then you can apply for a spot at the ALA if you are at least 16 years old, have at least 11 credits, and will be an incoming junior.

ALA DAILY STUDENT SCHEDULE & ATTENDANCE

Student Schedule: AM session students must work on their computer from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. weekdays; **PM session** students must work from 12:30-4:30 p.m. Students may also work outside of these hours in order to get ahead and finish courses more quickly. (Students follow their schedule for three, one-hour periods by checking in with their teacher; then, students are required to work an additional hour each day.) Students are always encouraged to work extra if possible—check out our new Saturday School opportunity!

Attendance is taken each period and teachers monitor student work during their scheduled session. It is VITAL students complete work each weekday. If they cannot attend their session, please contact the ALA at 480-362-2130 (leave a message, if prompted). Staying in communication helps us understand student needs and provide support, if needed.
