Suicide is not an easy topic to talk about, but it is happening in our cities, state and across the country. More teenagers and young adults die from suicide than from cancer, heart disease, AIDS, birth defects, stroke, pneumonia, influenza, and chronic lung disease, COMBINED. Suicide claims an average of more than 100 young lives each week. 4 out of 5 teens who attempt suicide have given clear warning signs. The need for open conversations and discussions in our homes, schools and communities, is greater now than ever. This event is meant to raise awareness of this stigmatized, and often taboo, topic. We want to share important information and spread hope.
